

USTA BATON ROUGE REGULATIONS
For USA League - Senior Mini Combo League - Addendum
League Year 2011

1.00 GENERAL.

1.02 GOVERNANCE. The USTA LEAGUE TENNIS REGULATIONS shall apply to the USTA League Program (USTA League). The RULES OF TENNIS and TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS including those for wheelchair play, shall apply to all matches played in the USTA League except as modified herein. In all matches played without officials, the USTA official publication, THE CODE, shall be observed. The USTA Point Penalty System shall be used at all championship levels.

1.02B(1) Amendments. The GBRCTA League Committee with approval of the Greater Baton Rouge Community Tennis Association may amend these Baton Rouge Regulations.

1.04C(1) Official League Registration. Tennis Link (<http://tennislink.usta.com/leagues/>) is the official system for registering teams and players for the USTA League.

1.04D(4)a. Team Registration Deadline. July 29, 2011

1.04D(4)b Player Registration Deadline. September 23, 2011

1.04D(4)d Financial Statement. The 2010 financial statement is included in Captains packet. Additional copies of the financial statement are available from the GBRCTA Baton Rouge League Administrator.

1.04D(4)e Enrollment Fees. The 2011 Baton Rouge Senior Combo league year enrollment fees are as follows: \$15.00 per player: \$5.00 per player to the Louisiana Tennis Association; \$7.00 per player for local league expenses; \$3.00 per player user fee for Tennis Link.

1.04E(4)c Electronic Devices. A player may not use electronic devices such as cell phones, digital messaging systems, radios, mp3 players, or any device capable of receiving communication during USTA League Tennis (The Code USTA Comment 30.1).

1.04F OFFICIAL LEAGUE RATING PROGRAM.

1.04G(2)b. A player may play only one NTRP level above the player's current NTRP level.

1.04F(1)e. A player with a NTRP published level must enter league play in accordance with the following:

2.01A Levels of Play. 5.5, 6.5, 7.5, and 8.5

2.01A(1) Days of Play. Senior Combo Women Day – Monday; Senior Combo Women Weekend – Saturday; Senior Combo Men – Saturday/Sunday. If needed, matches may be scheduled on alternate days/nights, to meet scheduling requirements.

2.01C(3)c Team Defaults. Any team defaulting or forfeiting the entire team match (playing less than a majority of the individual matches) twice, or once in flights with 6 or fewer matches, during a local league season may continue to play, but points won or lost by this team will not count in the final standings of the season. Additionally, a grievance may be filed against any team defaulting an entire team match during the last third (see Team Default Table) of the local league season or at any time during local league playoffs. Penalties may include, but are not limited to, removal of the team from standings (all matches voided); suspension of players from future league play;

2.01C(5)c. Local league matches will be canceled when the temperature (including wind chill) is below 40 degrees Fahrenheit at the start of the scheduled match unless both team captains agree to play.

2.02A(2) – Teams advancing to State Tournament Deposit - \$210.00 for all levels. See BR Regulation 2.02A(2) for instructions.

2.03D(1) State Championships. The 2011 teams advancing to the State Tournament will be: Each local league that enrolls a minimum of two (2) teams at an NTRP level shall send the winner to the State Tournament. Local leagues enrolling fourteen (14) or more teams at a specific NTRP level will receive two (2) entries and local leagues enrolling twenty-one (21) or more teams will receive three (3) entries.

2.03D(3).Team designation.

Will be based on order of finish in final local league standings as reported on Tennis Link. Any wildcard entries will go to the next highest ranking team in the final standings.
