

2008 BREC Rainout and Rescheduling Policy

Local League Regulations state:

BREC will issue a rain check in the event of inclement weather. Teams may reserve courts at the site where the match was originally scheduled. (Captains) reserve your courts before contacting Camille Siegel, hsiegel@bellsouth.net, to secure approval for rescheduled match dates/times. BREC will charge at the time of play for any courts booked and not marked as approved..... The host captain is responsible for reserving the courts for any rescheduled matches and, if applicable, paying court fees.

Note: BREC rain checks are valid for thirty (30) days. Rain checks are valid at the site of the originally scheduled match!!!!!! If courts are not available at the original site of the match, you may book courts at Greenwood for no additional court costs. You must still have the courts approved by Camille Siegel before play.

Regarding matches interrupted by inclement weather:

If a team match is in progress when inclement weather occurs, they must wait one-half hour before rescheduling.

Note: BREC will issue a rain check if courts are not playable within 30 minutes after scheduled start time. For example, match time is 6:30 p.m.; teams arrive; courts are damp. Teams squeegee the courts. Each team is responsible for one half of the match courts. If one team squeegees their half of the courts and they become playable only on that half and that Site Director (club or BREC) states that they are playable, then the match is on. If the other team has left the site or did not squeegee the match is declared a forfeit. If at 7:00 p.m. the courts are still too damp for play, BREC will issue a rain check. Teams scheduled to play at 8:00 p.m. may be able to play as scheduled. No 6:30 matches will start after 7:00 p.m. if there is an 8:00 p.m. match scheduled for the same courts!!!!
